## Guidelines for Grand Itasca Foundation Grants

*To enhance the availability of quality

## Eligibility and Interest

We welcome grant requests that focus on the health care needs in the region served by Grand Itasca Clinic & Hospital and meet one or more of the following criteria.

- \* Connecting people to health and Grand Itasca.
- \* Clearly show evidence of collaboration with other organizations and services with similar missions for optimum community impact and value.
- \* Initiate and support health related programs in response to expressed and/or proven needs.
- \* Fund health education for patients, families, professionals and the broader community.
- \* Fund new equipment for Grand Itasca and other charitable and governmental providers in the Grand Itasca service area.
- \* Focus community attention on important issues and concerns.

## Application Process

Proposals will be reviewed by Grand Itasca Foundation. We ask that you follow the procedures outlined in this publication and provide us with as complete information as possible.

All successful grant applications must submit a performance report to the Grand Itasca Foundation within 30 days after the project is completed. No further support will be considered unless a performance report is on file with Grand Itasca Foundation. Because resources are limited, not every request can be funded.

## Deadlines and Procedures

1. Deadlines: Applications must be received by the first day of January and July of each year.
2. You may be contacted by the Grand Itasca Foundation Director to answer questions about your grant application or provide an on-site visit to clarify your request.
3. Grand Itasca Foundation Grant Review Committee meets twice each year to review and make recommendations on grants. You may be asked to make a personal presentation at one of these meetings.
4. Grand Itasca Foundation will notify all grant applicants of their submitted grant status within 30 days of the application deadline.
