WHERE AND WHEN TO DONATE

Grand Itasca Clinic & Hospital, loading dock
1601 Golf Course Road
Donation drop off: Monday – Friday, 7am – 4:30pm

HOW TO DELIVER YOUR DONATIONS

1. Place all donation items in your trunk or non-passenger storage area of your vehicle.
2. Drive to the back of the clinic & hospital to the loading dock area
3. Ring doorbell at the door located just to the left of the docks
4. A staff member will come out to retrieve your donation

WHAT DONATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED

- Gloves
- Gowns (disposable)
- Surgical and clinical masks (Homemade accepted. See below for criteria.)
- N95 respirators
- Face shields
- Cleaning wipes with bleach (i.e. Clorox)
- Hand sanitizer swabs (Dacron, Rayon, Nylon)
